<p>The Faculty of Political Sciences, full member of the University of Sarajevo, has 46 long tradition of high education, and it is the only public institution for high education in the field of political sciences in BiH. Within the Faculty there are five departments: Department of Political Sciences, Department of Sociology, Department of Journalism, Department of Social Work and Department of Security and Peace Studies. More then 130 full time and associate academic staff works with app. 4.500 enrolled students at all level of study programmes. As organisational unit of the Faculty, the work of Institute for Social Research has been recently (re)activated, with its centres for research of local and regional self-government, public opinion, social conflicts, security and peace, social policy and European integrations.</p>

The major problem is for data entry and analysis utilizing relevant commercial software in order to maximize control and efficiency in the processing of data.</p>
