Department of Psychology is department of the Faculty of Philosophy, Sarajevo. Department offers graduate and post-graduate (Ma) education programmes and currently has 13 full-time staff members and cooperates with number of guest lecturers. There are plans for employment of additional staff (professors and professor assistants).
Per academic year, there are 250 graduate and 30 post-graduate students. Department of Psychology provides education in the field of general psychology, including courses in specific fields such as methodology of psychological research, social psychology, cognitive psychology, clinical psychology, mental health, educational psychology, developmental psychology, personal psychology, organizational and industrial psychology etc. There is strong need for research and practical work, both for staff members and the students.
Department of psychology currently develops project proposal for establishment of the Centre for Psychological Research. The Centre for Psychological Research will include the psychology laboratory. The Centre and the laboratory will be cornerstone for both the developing and conducting psychological research projects of the staff of the Department of Psychology and the practical education for the students of the Department. The Centre for Psychological Research will facilitate research in all fields of psychology that are represented in the curriculum of the Department of Psychology.
